I worked in this office for fifty-five years managing the real estate business begun by my father Peter. I was pleased to use my funds to support education and human rights endeavors.

NAHOF has survived the effects of a strange disease called a virus and is looking forward to resuming activities this year. The Cabinet of Freedom appreciates the volunteers that provided remote programs for February 2021 and 2022 in order to provide educational sessions for students and the general public. However, being closed because of that virus, meant that there was a significant decrease in income. NAHOF needs matching funds for grants to provide educational programs for history and equity. One project will continue reformatting videos in order to make them accessible, and another grant will engage the public in the reenactment and a commemoration of a movement against slavery.
